- i) Graduate or equivalent degree of a recognised University in Hindi in addition to English.
- ii) At least 5 years' experience in Translation work in any big establishment.

Desirable

- i) Knowledge of Bengali.
- ii) Typing speed 30 words per minute in Hindi.

2. Assistant- Librarian – 1 post
